### **1998 LUPINE HILL CABERNET SAUVIGNON**

#### **Winemaking Summary**

In 1997, we started our Lupine Hill Cabernet Sauvignon as our second designation for our wines. We would like to believe that all of the wine that we produce at Frazier Winery is excellent; however, our winemaker John Gibson performs extensive blending trials to come up with what he believes to be the best wine from each vintage. Each year he has wines that are left out of the Frazier Cabernet and Merlot. Some of these lots are sold in bulk to other wineries, but some which are complementary, John blends for our Lupine Hill label. The wine is not intended for long-term aging, but for everyday consumption of quality Napa Valley wines at a reasonable price.
