Tasting Notes

Textbook is what comes to mind when describing the 2007 vintage. It was a year of small berry sizes and lower than average cluster weight. The weather was moderate allowing the grapes to hang a few extra weeks to develop flavors at a nice even pace. This was a year where the wine made itself in the vineyard. We were fortunate to have **Robert M. Parker Jr.** review our wines last year in issue #186 of The Wine Advocate, he had the following to say about the wine:

"Exhibits an inky/purple color, a big, sweet nose of chocolate, cocoa, crème de cassis, blackberries, earth, and licorice. Dense, full-bodied, and opulent with an abundance of tannin as well as fruit, length, and depth. Give it 3-5 years of cellaring, and drink it over the next 25+."

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
