## 2007 FRAZIER PETIT VERDOT

**Blend:**

*91% Petit Verdot*

*9% Cabernet Sauvignon*

**Alcohol:** *15%*

**Case Production:**

*60 cases x 750ml*

*Bottled unfinned & unfiltered*

### *Tasting Notes*

The 2007 Frazier Petit Verdot is our second foray into producing a wine from this Bordeaux varietal. Some of you may recall we produced a version of this wine from the 2004 vintage.

For our 2007 Petit Verdot we blended in 9% Cabernet Sauvignon to the Petit Verdot to balance the structure of the wine with the ripe, round, accessible fruit the Cabernet Sauvignon provides. This wine, much like the 2004 Petit Verdot, is one built for the cellar. The wine has a dark ruby core to it. This is a spicy wine with mouth coating tannins, dark fruit and red fruits. The finish is very long and may drink bigger than any other wine in your cellar.

For those unfamiliar with Petit Verdot, it is noted for its intensity of color, structure, and ability to age. This wine will age gracefully but should drink well from mid 2011-2025.
