## 2008 FRAZIER CABERNET SAUVIGNON

**Blend:**

*100% Cabernet Sauvignon*

**Bottled:** *February 2011*

*Bottled unfined & unfiltered*

**Alcohol:** *15.5%*

**Ageing:** *24 months French Oak*

**Case Production:**

*600 cases x 750ml*

**Cellar Potential:** *10-15 years*

## *Tasting Notes*

Dark purple, almost opaque in color. Nose initially reveals light notes of cedar, menthol, earth, and dry dusty tannins. After allowing this wine to open in the glass, the nose shows blue/ black berry compote, plums, and a hint of restrained espresso. The palate initially shows a wall of tannin but 2 hours after opening there is nice concentration and a wonderful mouth feel, though the fruit still a bit in the background. At the 3 hour mark the wine becomes alive. Mouth feel is incredibly smooth. No hint of oak but there is dark fruit on the nose and a wonderful entry on the palate which leads to a long, unctuous finish. We plan on enjoying this wine well into the next decade.
