80% Petit Verdot 10% Cabernet Sauvignon 10% Merlot

Tasting Notes

The 2008 Petit Verdot has a huge nose of black fruits and berries. The expressive nose gives way to a bit of toasty oak and a hint of ripe tannin on the finish. Once open for a few hours the wine drops most traces of oak from the nose and produces rich aromas of roasted coffee beans and deep blue and black fruits which are not only on the nose but palate as well. On the front palate, roasted meat and a hint of earth complement the robust fruit. The expansive mid palate and long finish beg for a slow-cooked pasta sugo or meat dish to thoroughly awaken this wine. This wine will live for years if properly stored in the cellar.

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
