## *Tasting Notes*

Intense aromas of graphite, cassis, black cherries, and a hint of dark chocolate give a glimpse into what this wine is all about. On the palate, the ripe dark red and black fruit is perfectly balanced by a bit of toasty oak and a backbone of bright acidity. The use of 30% new French oak frames all the components together while staying firmly in the background. Flavors of red currents, wild game, new leather, and dark chocolate can all be found in perfect harmony in this wine. The concentrated palate ends with wonderful length. This wine will benefit from 2-3 hours in the decanter and should age through 2020.
